## *Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 11-01-11 through 11-30-11*

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 93 calls for service for the month November 2011.

The Department reports 26 total citations listing 32 traffic violations, 6 written verbal warnings, and 9 misdemeanor charges arrests statistics for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

The Department reports 10 custodial arrests for the month. (See attached arrest report)

### Training:

A total of 86 hours of training are reported for this month. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) At the request of the South Unit State Park Manager Dale Shagena, I hosted an Emergency Management meeting at the Police Department with Fire/EMS Chief Patchin and Asst Fire/EMS Chief Lippert in attendance as well. The meeting was to discuss the State Parks Emergency management plan so that he could have an internal and external plan in place for them. The discussions centered on evacuations of the Park if necessary, sites for temporary shelter, Red Cross sites and proper activation chain to assure the best outcomes.
- 2) I met with Officer Williams reference Project Blue Light organization.
- 3) I attended an MACP focus group for the purpose of redefining the mission of the MACP and providing a strategic plan to achieve the desired results to benefit Police Chiefs throughout Michigan.
- 4) I attended the Township Board monthly work session as required.
- 5) I attended 2 ACT-NOW Executive Board meetings in my Advisory role to facilitate plans for the Silent Auction to benefit Shop with a Cop held at the Good Shepherd United Methodist of the North Church.
- 6) I met with the Halloween 2011 committee for debriefing meeting and planning session for the 2012 event.
- 7) I sat on an oral interview panel for the hiring of a 911 Dispatcher position. Two candidates were interviewed.
- 8) I chaired two Kids Helping Kids at Christmas meeting to provide Christmas for Foster Children in Roscommon County.

9) I assisted with the set up, program and take down of the Silent Auction Dinner and Auction held on 11-21-11 for the 2011 Shop with a Cop benefit.

Other noteworthy items;

The Police Department received a full Audit of its Criminal Justice records that are maintained in the Law Enforcement Information Network and National Crime information center and received a Satisfactory rating for the audit. The Department receives audits from the Criminal Justice Information Center at the Michigan State Police.

All Officers of the Department except those on current leaves received 6 hours of Electronic Control Device (Taser) training and the ECD's are now in service. Additionally, the Officers have recertified in off duty weapons, duty shotgun training and CPR/AED this past month.
