EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit shall expire one (1) year after issuance. At that time it may be renewed for an additional year by request and paying the base permit fee and for any additional work or inspections needed. If work for which a permit is issued is not started within six (6) months of the date of permit issuance or if work is abandoned for a period of six (6) months, then the permit shall lapse and cease to be in effect. CANCELLED PERMITS CAN NOT BE REINSTATED.

A PLAN REVIEW may be required before work is started on any building other than a single family dwelling less than 3,500 square feet or alterations that cost less than \$10,000.00.
