## *Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 01-01-11 through 01-31-11*

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 103 calls for service for the month January 2011.

The Department reports 14 various custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 27 citations. (See attached for breakdown).

### Training:

A total of 66 hours of training are reported for this month. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I attended a debriefing meeting of the Kids helping Kids at Christmas program.
- 2) I attended and assisted a CERT Radio communication training scenario.
- 3) I attended the regular Monthly work session with the Township Board.
- 4) I attended the regular monthly Board meeting for the Township.
- 5) I attended and chaired the 911 Technical Board meeting and been elected as the Chair person for that board for 2011 year.
- 6) I attended a Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police Meeting as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-President for the organization.
- 7) I attended 3 CERT Fun Run/Training organizational and planning meetings for the rollout of a May 2011 dual training session with the Crawford County CERT organization. Emphasis will be placed on Incident Command function, Communications, Geographical Orientation, Compass use, First Aid/CPR, Search and Rescue, Splinting, Fire Safety and Triage.
- 8) I met with Clerk Valentino regarding various liaison related issues.
- 9) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting.
- 10) I attended the Monthly Administrator's/Investigator's meeting held at Central Dispatch this month.
- 11) I attended a Bomb Threat Assessment training seminar in Gaylord, Mi.
- 12) I attended the required LEIN recertification training class held at Central Dispatch.
- 13) I met with an interested College Intern and went over the required paperwork for submission of an application to have an intern experience at our Department in cooperation with Kirtland Community College Criminal Justice program.

14) I had a teleconference with MSP UCR analyst Cherish Leverich regarding the Department's on going efforts to gain certification with the MSP and the FBI with the use of the E-justice RMS we are currently using for incident reports.

15) I conducted an Emergency driving law update at the Gerrish Township Fire Dept. per their request.

16) I arranged for and participated in a K-9 Drug search of the Roscommon High School at the request of the building Assistant Principal.

As some further notes this month;

The Department was able to locate and rescue a lost Cross Country skier in the Marl Lake trails area with the use of the Department 6x6 Ranger received on a grant in 2007.

Additionally the entire Department has been recertified as required on the use of the LEIN. The requirement is that all LEIN users do so every two years.

The entire Department evaluations have been completed on schedule as in the years past.

Additionally, the GTPD and friends will be participating in the 2011 Winterfest at the North State Park in the Broomball competition on 2-19-11. Any board member who wishes to be included on our team needs only tell us and we will add you. It is a very physical game but much fun is had and the proceeds go to the Roscommon High School Project Graduation 2011.

Our ACT-NOW group continues it fundraising efforts this new year by initiating the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual ACT-NOW Snowmobile/ATV Poker Fun Run on February 26, 2011.
