## ***Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 04-01-11 through 04-30-11***

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 118 calls for service for the month April 2011.

The Department reports 6 custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 29 citations listing a total of 37 charges and 12 verbal warnings on same for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

### Training:

No training hours are reported this month. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I was assigned and completed an internal Administration Investigation as directed by the board
- 2) I attended the regular Township board work session as required.
- 3) I met with the Supervisor as requested regarding many Township business issues.
- 4) I attended two CERT planning meetings for the upcoming training blitz scheduled for May 14, 2011.

- 7) I attended a special ACT NOW Executive Board meeting for the scholarship review and selection of recipients.
- 8) I met with State Representative Bruce Rendon and other Law Enforcement Administrators to discuss current legislation that will affect our Departments and governmental bodies.
- 9) I chaired the Roscommon County E911 Technical Board meeting.
- 10) I attended the monthly Investigators/Administrators meeting held at Kirtland Community College this month.
- 11) I attended the MACP District 9 elections held at Kirtland Community College. Richfield Township Public Safety Director Brad Bannon was selected as District 9 Representative and Doug Baum, Chief of Grayling City Police Department was selected as his alternate.

Highlights this month for the Department include;

The 2011 April "Prescription Drug drop" held on April 30, 2011 netted over 8 lbs this year. I would like to extend my thanks to Officer Norm LaBonte who coordinates this activity for our Department.

ACT-NOW and the Police Department have agreed once again to partner on the "Scrap Metal Project".
