Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 11-01-09 through 11-30-09

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 120 calls for service for the month November 2010.

The Department reports 33 citation and arrests statistics for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

Training:

A total of 38 hours of training are reported for this month. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I hosted and chaired two Kids helping Kids at Christmas meetings to correlate the 2nd Annual event that serves all foster children and their families for a night of entertainment, Christmas gifts and dinner.
- 2) I participated in three lockdown drills for our area schools. The lockdown drills are performed to assist in the education of students and staff at the local schools in the event of an unexpected emergency situation.
- 4 I attended the monthly Board work session as required.
- 5) I participated in the ACT-NOW Shop with a Cop Silent Auction and dinner held at the Good Shepherd United Methodist of the North Church.
- 6) I participated in one ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting
- 7) I attended the regular monthly board meeting as required.
- 8) I met with the Halloween 2010 committee for debriefing meeting and planning session for the 2011 event.
- 9) I met with the 911 Director and Deputy Director regarding of the dispatching of calls after administration hours not being uniform with the Mutual Aid agreement signed by all agencies.
- 10) I met with Clerk Valentino and Lyon Twp Supervisor reference Law enforcement statistics for the past three years in Lyon Twp with very preliminary discussions of a needs assessment regarding services in their Township.
- 11) I traveled to the homes of applicants for our 2010 Shop with a Cop program with ACT-NOW Chair Mary Link and ACT-NOW Treasurer Bob Barber. Each year we personally visit with the applicants to gain a better understanding of their needs and qualification to be the beneficiary of our groups' efforts.
